

Glossary of Fishing Terminology

Native: Any indigenous species that was present within the sub-basin prior to European settlement.

Non-native or introduced: Any species introduced by humans to an area where it did not exist prior to European settlement.

Natural production: Reproduction of species is without the influence of hatchery production or hatchery-influenced populations have reproduced in the wild for at least one reproductive cycle.

Hatchery production: Fish are propagated in a hatchery and released into a body of water.

Mixed production: Reproduction from a mix of hatchery, native, and/or introduced populations.

Stocked: Tells you whether hatchery propagated fish have been released by ODFW into a particular water body.
